What are Biobased Composite Panels?

A biobased composite panel is a type of building material used in place of traditional wood or steel. These panels are much more lightweight than solid wood or steel but offer similar levels of strength and structural support. While biobased composite panels are composed mainly of wood and corn, some are made of unique raw materials like wheat, soy, hemp, rice, algae and municipal solid waste.

In our Catalog, there are composite panels for countertops, acoustics, plastic lumber, structural interiors, walls, and interiors. Structural Wall Panels have the highest biobased content requirement at 94%.

 We also have Wood and Concrete Sealers for treating decks, patios and outdoor spaces. These liquids are formulated to protect wood or concrete from damage caused by insects, moisture, and decaying fungi. Examples include PoreShield[™], Pro Tech Series by Black Diamond Coatings, Royal Wood or SoySeal Wood Sealer & Waterproofer.

A Path to Home Ownership



The BioPreferred Program is just one of many programs administered by USDA Rural Development. Some of its most important programs include those which help people finance, refinance or repair their single-family homes. These lending and grant programs include:

- <u>Single Family Housing Direct Home Loans</u> This program assists low- and very-low-income applicants obtain decent, safe and sanitary housing in eligible rural areas by providing payment assistance to increase an applicant's repayment ability.
- <u>Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loan Program</u> The Section 502 Guaranteed Loan Program assists approved lenders in providing low- and moderate-income households the opportunity to own adequate, modest, decent, safe and sanitary dwellings as their primary residence in eligible rural areas.
- <u>Single Family Housing Repair Loans & Grants</u> This program provides loans to very-lowincome homeowners to repair, improve or modernize their homes or grants to elderly verylow-income homeowners to remove health and safety hazards.
- <u>Single Family Housing Rural Disaster Home Repair Grants</u> What does this program do? It provides grants to very-low and low-income homeowners to repair homes damaged in a Calendar Year (CY) 2022 Presidentially Declared Disaster Area.
- Native Community Development Financial Institution Relending Demonstration Program

 What does this program do? The Native Community Development Financial Institution (Native CDFI) Relending Demonstration Program is designed to improve homeownership opportunities for Native American Tribes, Alaska Native Communities, and Native Hawaiian Communities in rural areas.
